Dredging Equipment Rental Checklist What to Ask Before You Rent

1. Pre-Rental Planning

Make sure the equipment you're renting actually fits your project scope, timeline, and environment.

- ☐ Have you defined the project location, sediment type, and site conditions?
- □ Do you know which type of dredging equipment (suction, pump, etc) your job requires?
- □ Have you confirmed project duration and potential extension options with your team?
- □ Did you budget for mobilization and demobilization costs?
- □ Are there permits or environmental regulations that affect your equipment choice or schedule?

2. Contract & Liability Questions

Every rental agreement is different. Understand what's covered and what's not before signing.

- □ Does the rental include delivery, setup, and retrieval of equipment?
- □ What's the minimum rental period and how are extensions or delays handled?
- □ Who is liable for equipment damage or loss during transport or use?
- □ Is there insurance coverage included, or do you need to provide your own?
- ☐ Are there hidden fees (cleaning, standby, refueling, etc.) in the fine print?
- ☐ How soon can the provider mobilize equipment after contract signing?

3. Safety & Training

Proper operation and safety training are critical for dredging efficiency and crew protection.

- □ Will the provider offer operator training or certification on-site?
- ☐ Are there safety manuals or standard operating procedures (SOPs) included?
- □ Does the equipment meet OSHA and Coast Guard safety standards?
- ☐ Are emergency shutdown and communication protocols explained to your crew?
- □ Are personal protective equipment (PPE) recommendations provided?

4. Equipment Inspection & Readiness Inspect everything before deployment to avoid breakdowns and unexpected downtime.

□ Did vou receive a pre-rental inspection report or check

- Did you receive a pre-rental inspection report or checklist from the provider?
- □ Have you verified that all hoses, fittings, and pipelines are leak-free?
- □ Are the pump impellers and seals in working condition?
- □ Are all gauges, lights, and electrical systems functional?
- □ Does the equipment include spare parts or backup units?
- □ Is there proof of recent maintenance or service logs?

5. Logistics & Support

- □ Who is your main point of contact for project updates and technical issues?
- □ Is there a backup plan or alternate equipment available if breakdowns occur?
